- Monthly dues are part of the commitment to a club program. Attendance will be taken starting in January, 2018. If you are not registered on the Renegades website, please do so immediately. - Attendance is a major success factor for the teams. Please show up for practice and sign up for tournaments!
- It is <u>mandatory</u> that all players are registered with USA Water Polo, <u>www.usawaterpolo.org</u>. It provides the players and club with liability insurance and the ability to participate in USWP sanctioned events. A Silver membership is acceptable but you must be a Gold Athlete to compete in Junior Olympics. <u>ALL</u> memberships expire on December 31, 2017. <u>Memberships will</u> <u>be verified and players will not be allowed in the</u> water after January 1, 2018 without it!!
- The Board voted in November, 2017 to increase monthly dues from \$125 to \$135 per month (effective February 1st, 2018) as well as increase the Annual Membership Fee from \$40 to \$50 (effective February, 2018). Please feel free to attend the monthly board meetings if you have budgetary questions!
